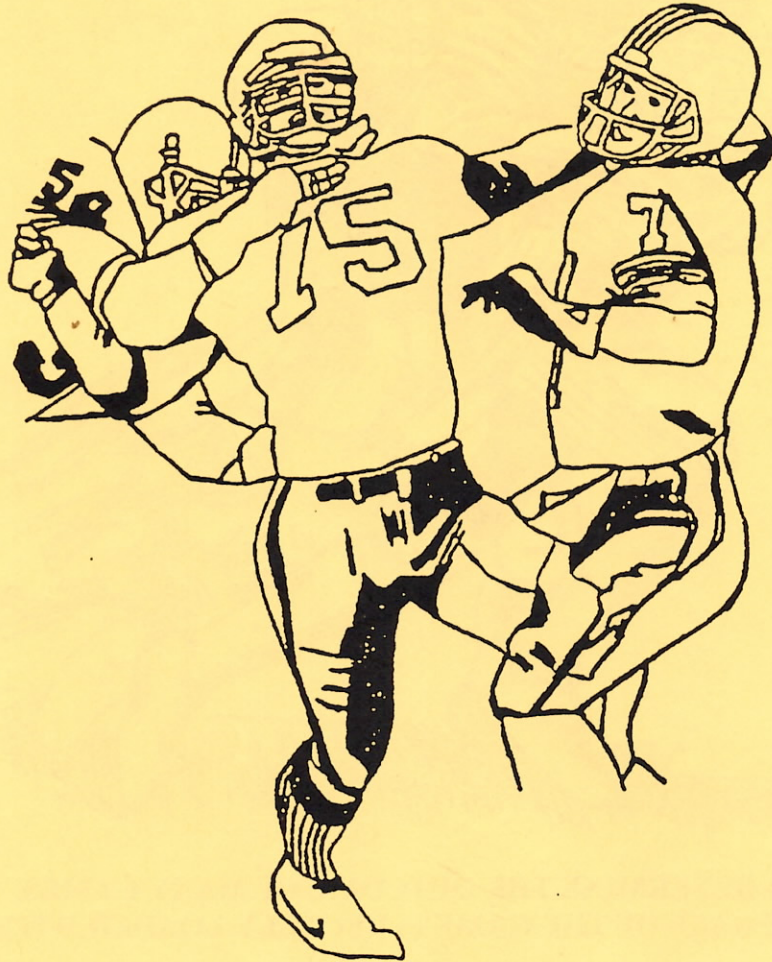


ONE ON ONE

FOOTBALL IS A SERIES OF ONE ON ONE MATCHUPS. THE RESULT OF THESE MATCHUPS DETERMINE THE SUCCESS OR FAILURE OF EVERY PLAY AND DETERMINE DOMINANCE AT THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE. IF ONE TEAM DOMINATES THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE, EITHER THROUGH SUPERIOR PHYSICAL CAPABILITIES OR BETTER COACHING TECHNIQUE, IT REALLY LIMITS THE INVENTORY WHICH MAY BE EMPLOYED BY THE OPPOSITION.



ONE ON ONE CONFRONTATIONS VARY FROM BRUTAL LINE PLAY TO A BALLET BETWEEN OFFENSIVE RECEIVERS AND SECONDARY PERSONNEL. LARRY MARMIE, THE DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR AT ARIZONA STATE SAID, "BEFORE YOU CAN LEARN SCHEME AND PHILOSOPHY YOU HAVE TO LEARN HOW TO DEFEAT YOUR OPPONENT ONE ON ONE".

THE LIBERALIZATION OF THE USE OF HANDS AND ARMS BY THE OFFENSE HAS ENCOURAGED THE BENDING OF RULES TO COMPENSATE FOR PHYSICAL DIFFERENCES IN OPPONENTS. AS OFFICIALS WE MUST BE AWARE OF THE INDIVIDUAL MATCHUP THAT OCCURS ON EACH PLAY AND EVALUATE THE EFFECT OF LIBERALIZED USE OF HANDS AND ARMS ON EACH PLAY.
