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Referee Presentation - JULY 22, 2015

Consider the following (from Chris Wiggins) for pregame topics and assign them to different officials during the year:

- Starting game & periods on time
 - Overtime
 - Playing time and extended periods
 - Timeouts, starting & stopping clock
 - Delay of game
 - Substitutions
 - Ball in play
 - Down and possession after penalty
 - Series and fouls related to series
 - Free kicks – formation, touching, blocking, out-of-bounds
 - Scrimmage kicks
 - Fair catch & opportunity to catch
 - Backward pass
 - Progress
 - Forward pass
 - Touchdown & Pylon
 - Try down
 - Field goal
 - Safety & touchback
 - Force
 - Personal fouls
 - Unsportsmanlike conduct
 - Blocking and use of hands
 - Batting & kicking
 - Fighting & flagrant personal fouls

Referees 2015

Free Kicks

- Primary focus and peripheral focus
- You know the template
- Off receiver will take you to the action
- Good color – bad color
- Move slowly

Scrimmage Plays

- QB hands and body parts and backs
- 13-15 deep and 13-15 wide (outside of TE)
- Good colors – bad colors
- Blocks from center to outside (1-2-3-4 quickly)
- Handoff in peripheral
- R must help on blocks to outside (3-4)
- Going away 2-3 steps at 45 degrees
- Up field dead ball officiate

Pass Plays

- First LT
- Second RT
- Third QB
- Good color – bad color
- When QB threatened view shoulders up

Punt Play

- 6/6 yards behind punter
- Shield and punter
- Judge snap
- Focus on signal caller
- End line threatened – off end line
- Transition – red, red, red to white, white, white
- Split field with umpire right & left
- Hand up means “help”
- Point and other official finds a line
- Never lose track of punter
- Run through feet of punter

Field Goal & PAT

- Slightly behind and very wide
- Template
- Focus on holder
- Strong side - weak side – kicker
