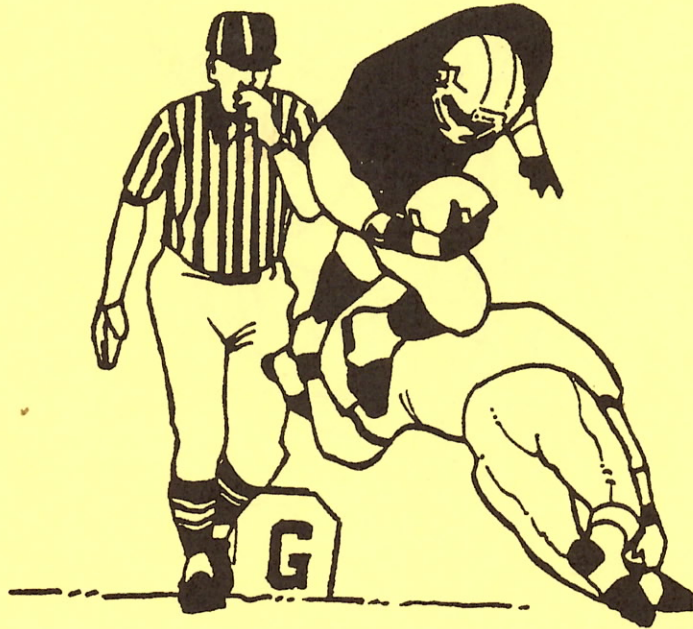


COVERAGE IN THE RED ZONE



Offensive teams designate the area from the Team "B" 20 yard line to the goal line as the 'Red Area'. This is an area where points production is an **absolute requirement**. This is also a field area where the officiating team must deliver a coordinated approach, supported by unfaltering judgement. This is "*THE*" area of the field for everyone involved in the game.

Please review goal line mechanics with the following thoughts

- Side lines and end lines are critical and positioning for the officials is a primary concern.
- L,- LJ,- SJ,- FJ coordinate side line and end line responsibilities. This is a primary pregame conference item.
- Spot of snap on or inside Team "B" 5 yard line LJ and L have complete goal line and side line responsibility. Remember pylon coverage.
- Communication and coordination prior to and after the snap. Work for the best possible position. BE A THE GOAL LINE!
- Primary coverage requires exact positioning and the elimination of guess work

BE POSITIVE AND SELL YOUR CALL AT THE GOAL LINE
